- Public Hearing on First Report on 2020-2021 Rating Based on 2019-2020
 Data
 - Chief Financial Officer Joey Jones presented the data on the FIRST Report on 2020-2021 Ratings Based on 2019-2020 Data. The FIRST Report The rating system is based on 20 indicators and uses student data and the District's annual financial audit to help measure financial performance. The ratings were based upon an analysis of staff and student data reported for the 2019-2020 school year.

Board Monitoring

- Board Goal Monitoring
 - This monthly progress monitoring session is designed to discuss student and teacher progress in selected areas as it relates to the board's goals.
 - The high achievers' recognition for students and staff honored celebrating our seniors who are securing the future and expanding their

post-secondary opportunities through the completion of at least one industry-based certification since May 2021 in the following categories: Cosmetology Operator License, Floral Design, Microsoft Office Specialist, Osha 30 Safety, and SERV safe Food Manager. The Board and Administration also recognized the teachers who provided high-quality instruction to prepare students to meet the requirements of the certification.

- The progress measures covered in this agenda presentation included data review and conversations around **Board Goal 1: College, Career, and Military Readiness.**
- Superintendent Constraints Monitoring
 - Constraints #2: Professional Development (CPMs 2.2, and 2.3)
 - Superintendent Dr. D'Andre Weaver presented information regarding the district's steps toward ensuring a professional development plan for all educators.
- Information (Discussion Only)
 - o The Board Corrective Action Plan update was presented by President Fleming.
 - This brief presentation of the Board Corrective Action Plan identified the focus points for the next six months of the plan which will end in April 2022. The trustees will focus on many of the same areas but with more depth. There was one progress monitoring addition to the Set the Vision objective, three in the Focus on the Vision, and one in the Communicating the Vision objectives of the new CAP plan.
 - The Administration Corrective Action Plan update was shared by Superintendent Weaver.
 - The Academics objective will remain centered on classrooms and teacher training, the Finance objective will focus on improving the annual financial rating of the district and progress measures that indicate direction. The Talent Management section will remain focused on recruiting and training certified teachers and capacity building of staff for the upcoming year.

The conservator noted the impact of the national shortage to meet these metrics.


